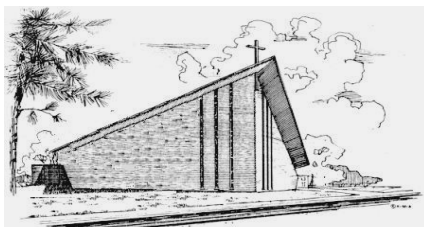

Well, we are off to a rousing start on the Scrip Program for the year 2012. Through the month of January we sold \$12,090, for a profit to the church of \$604.50. We are projecting sales of \$140,000 for a profit of \$7,000 for the year. If we meet our projection, this will be the highest year ever. I know we can make our projection because we have almost been there before. The highest sales year we have ever experienced was \$137,600, and this is only \$2,400 more. We are happy to deliver Scrip during the week to enhance the participation. Scrip sales are enhanced by the continuous participation by the Congregation. It is constant use that helps the sales not just the amount. If you only spend 20 or 40 dollars per week it still adds up over the year.
